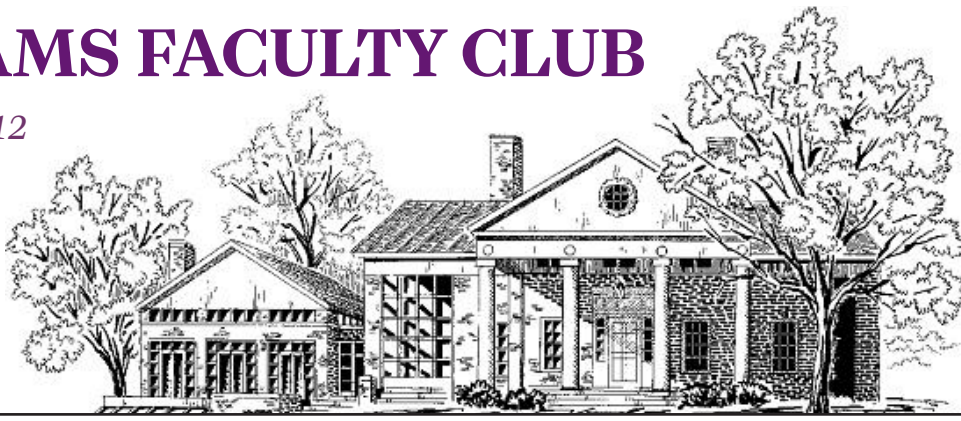

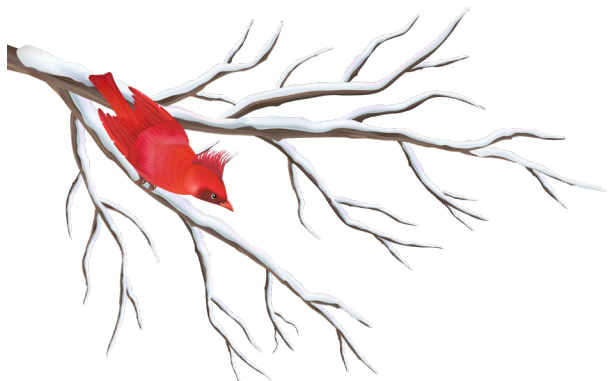
## **Lunch Buffet Menus**
